What We Do:

Sexual Assault/Rape Crisis Centre of Peel (SA/RCCP) is a non-profit charitable agency that provides counselling support services to survivors of historic and current sexual violence, in particular women survivors and their support persons, in the Region of Peel.

The Sexual Assault/Rape Crisis Centre of Peel is committed to providing barrier and discrimination-free services to all female survivors, 16 years of age and older. This includes, but is not limited to, seniors, youth, disabled and racialized women, and women with different sexual orientations in compliance with all the intersecting prohibited grounds of the Human Rights Code and the Accessibility Ontario Disability Act.

The Sexual Assault/Rape Crisis Centre of Peel provides crisis support services to male survivors through the Crisis Line Program.

All programs and services are free.

Services Offered:

1. Counselling Services - Individual and Group Counselling for women survivors of sexual violence and their support persons
2. Crisis Services – Telephone Crisis Support Services to all survivors through the Crisis Line
3. Volunteer Program – provides opportunities for volunteer services (in particular with the Crisis Line program)
4. Case Management – individual case management including:
 - ✓ Advocacy – including assistance in recent sexual assault with various institutions such as:
 - Police
 - Hospitals
 - Sexual Assault Care Centres – Chantal Place
 - Housing
 - Social Assistance, etc.
 - ✓ Referrals
 - ✓ Court Supports
