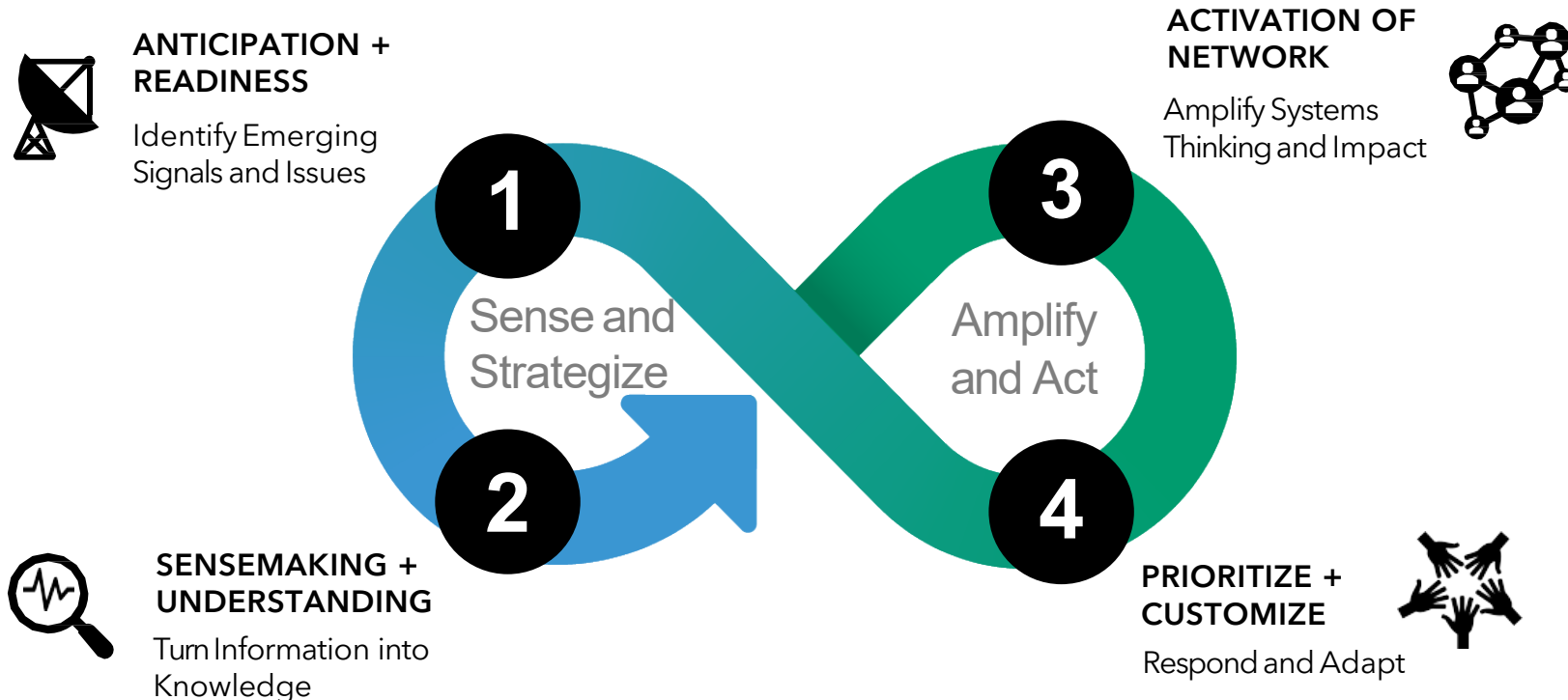

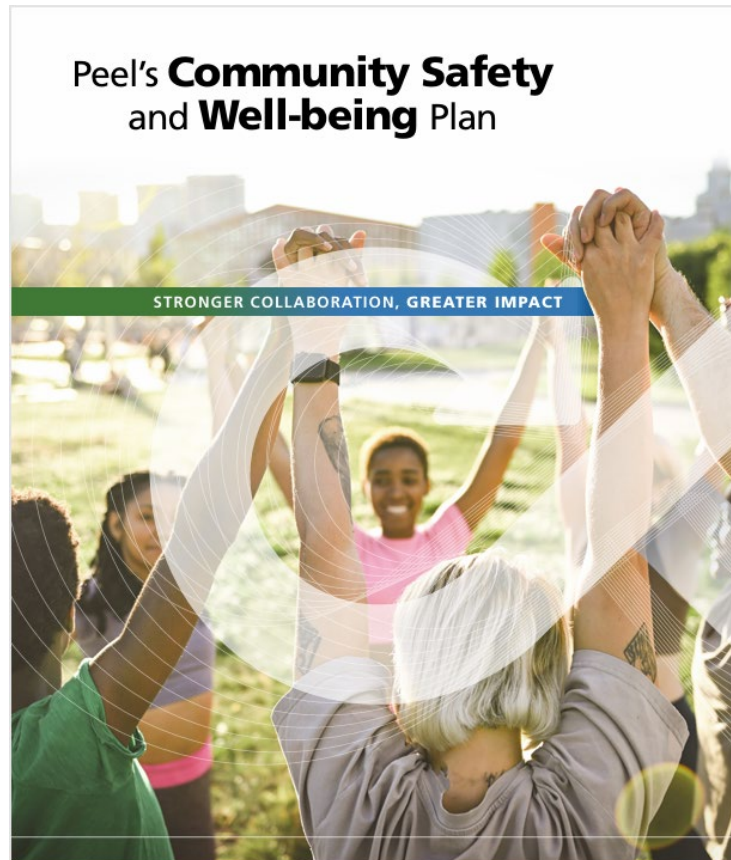

# Building Safer Communities Fund

**32** health and social services agencies, police, educational institutions, and government partners and **240 youth, parents and caregivers** came together to identify youth violence prevention priorities for Peel.

With **\$8.1 Million** over 3 years from Public Safety Canada, **26** youth-serving community organizations delivered upstream interventions, reaching **10,000+** youth and improving risk and protective factors for youth violence in Peel.

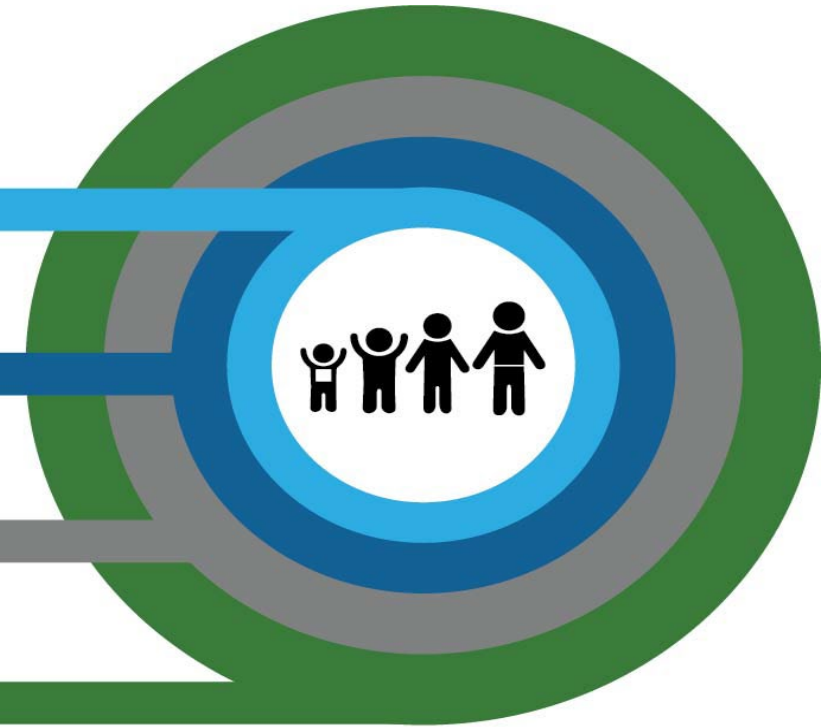
CSWB will prioritize addressing the needs of children and youth to drive upstream, systems level change.

Peel is home to one of the **youngest and fastest-growing youth** populations in Canada

Early upstream child and youth investments are **one of the most powerful and equitable ways** to shift community wellbeing

# CSWB Plan Goals

## Healthy in Body + Mind + Spirit

Children + youth have the support they need to be physically, mentally, emotionally + spiritually well

## Equitable Access to Opportunities + Stability

Children, youth + families can access education, jobs + the basics of everyday life, like housing, food + income to build secure futures

## Strong Relationships + Belonging

Children + youth feel connected, cared for + valued by their families, peers + communities.

## All children + youth in Peel are safe, supported + thriving

## Safe, Inclusive Places to Grow

Schools, neighbourhoods + community spaces feel safe, welcoming + inclusive for all identities + cultures.

## Youth Voice, Agency + Leadership

Children and youth contribute to decisions that affect them + have opportunities to co-design + lead their communities and futures.

# CSWB Plan Priorities



## Transforming Outcomes for Children and Youth

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- Implementing priority actions to advance **strategic focus on children + youth (ages 0-24)**
- 3 Priority Actions advancing strategic focus on middle childhood (7-14 years)
- 6 Targeted Initiatives to advance child + youth well-being (0-24 years)



## Mobilizing Systems Leadership

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- 4 priority actions focused on **removing barriers, enabling coordination + systems integration** to advance CSWB Model
- **Longer term, systems-level actions**, not only focused on children + youth
