NEW BUSINESS

2. **OPP – 2025 3rd Quarter Operations/Statistical Analysis Report** – The Board considered the 2025 3rd Quarter Operations Summary and Statistical Analysis report with respect to policing the Town of Caledon by Inspector N. Majer, OPP Caledon Detachment Commander. The reports provided statistics and analysis for July - September 2025 for the following areas:

- Public Complaints
- Motor Vehicle Collisions
- Criminal Code and Provincial Statute Charges Laid
- Violent Crime
- Property Crime
- Drug Crime
- Clearance Rates

Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) – Updates and Community Safety Initiatives – Inspector N, Majer and her colleague, Operational Support Sgt. Vijay Rai provided a presentation.

Inspector N. Majer reported that Detective Constable Lori Mournahan of the Caledon OPP Detachment was named the 2024 recipient of the OPP Supporting Victims of Crime – Individual Award, recognizing her victim-centred work and contributions to improving outcomes for vulnerable persons. Members congratulated Detective Constable Mournahan.

Inspector N. Majer provided a brief update **on** Project Handel, advising that a person of interest was arrested on November 25, 2025, and charged in connection with a homicide and attempted murders. The investigation remains ongoing.

Inspector N. Majer also reported an increase in extortion-related incidents in Caledon and highlighted ongoing joint task force efforts with Peel Regional Police and other partners.

Inspector N. Majer advised that development is underway on the 2026–2029 Caledon Detachment Action Plan, aligned with the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019, and the OPP Strategic Plan, noting recent recruitment growth and an anticipated launch in the new year.

Sergeant V. Rai provided a high-level overview of several grant-funded initiatives, including expanded CCTV coverage, enhanced victim support services, mental health crisis response (M-CERT), data-driven violence prevention (CSP/Project IRIS), CAMSAFE, Community Watch, **and** Project Safe Trade, all aimed at strengthening proactive, intelligence-led policing and community safety in Caledon.
